Cherry or Grape Tomato, 160 plugs or 2 grams

### Pest Management

Fertilizer, starter and sidedress  
Herbicide, Roundup or similar  
Insecticidal Soap, Safer or other  
Backpack Sprayers, 2

5'-6' Stakes  
Peat Pots
