2010 Delaware 4-H Equine Art Contest Results

Delaware 4-H members of all ages recently participated in a statewide Equine Art Contest sponsored by the Delaware 4-H Horse Advisory Committee, a group of volunteer 4-H Equine Project Leaders. Entries from 35 budding artists were submitted for the contest in the following categories:
