Individual Participation – Open to all 4-Hers

☘ Classroom Training Dates – If you attend one classroom training, you will receive 150 points towards your final score; however, you are encouraged to attend both trainings.

- March 18th Wednesday Kent Extension Office 6:30 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

☘ On the Farm Trainings – Each practice will include one practice class, two judging classes, one set of oral reasons or questions* for a total of 150 points at each event

- May 13th Wednesday Schiffs 6:30 p.m. Beef
- May 27th Wednesday Jackson's 6:30 p.m. Swine
- June 4th 10th Wednesday Bobola's 6:30 p.m. Sheep

*Oral reasons will be required of the seniors (12 and up) and five questions will be asked of juniors (11 and under) regarding the class.

The lowest 'placing score' and the lowest 'oral reasons/questions' score will be dropped.

The ten highest placing seniors will be invited and encouraged to participate in Livestock Judging at the Delaware State Fair. If the other two counties do not use their ten slots, then more slots will become available. Preference is given to senior participants.

Team Makeup

- ☘ Team members may be members from any club; mixed teams are permitted
- ☘ Teams may consist of up to four members
- ☘ No more than two members may be Seniors (12 and up)
- ☘ No more than two members may be Juniors (11 and under)

Scoring

- ☘ Team score will be a composite score, compiled by adding the individual scores of the team members.
