

Hippity Hoppity Rabbits

Objective: To teach students the different breeds of bunnies as well as the parts of a rabbit

Materials:

- Bunny Poster (See below)
- Parts of the Bunny worksheet (Make copies)
- Wood Cut Outs of Bunnies
- Markers, paint, popsicle sticks, glue
- Cardstock Bunny Copy
- White icing, large and small marshmallows

10 minutes: Introduction of the Bunny with Poster

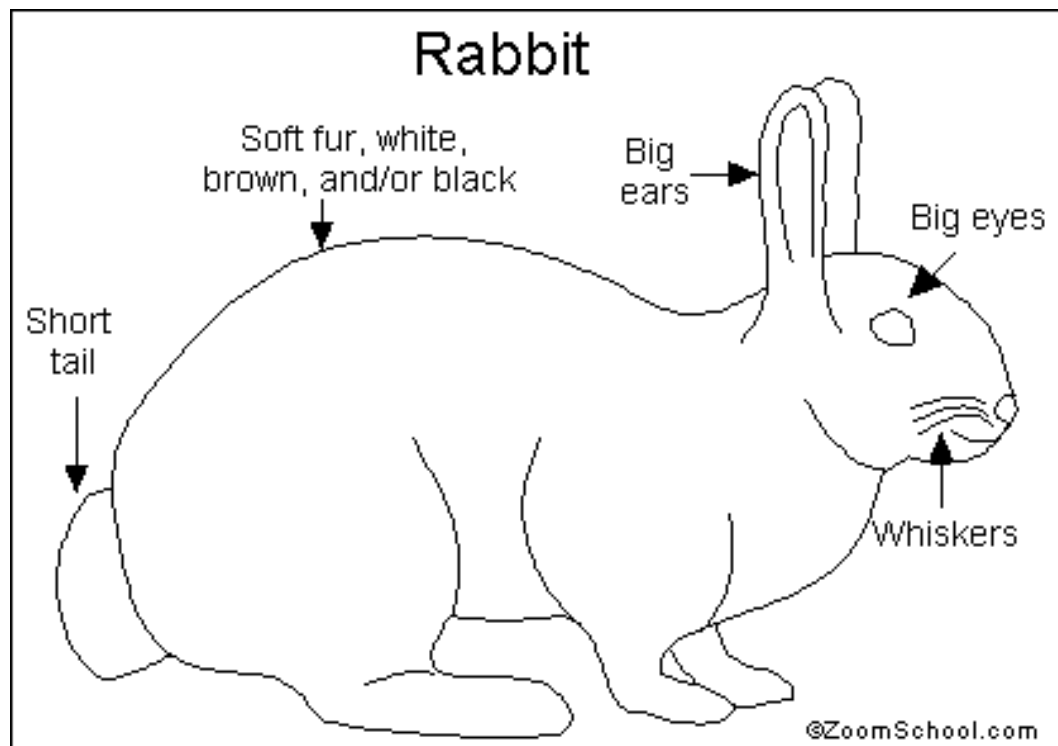
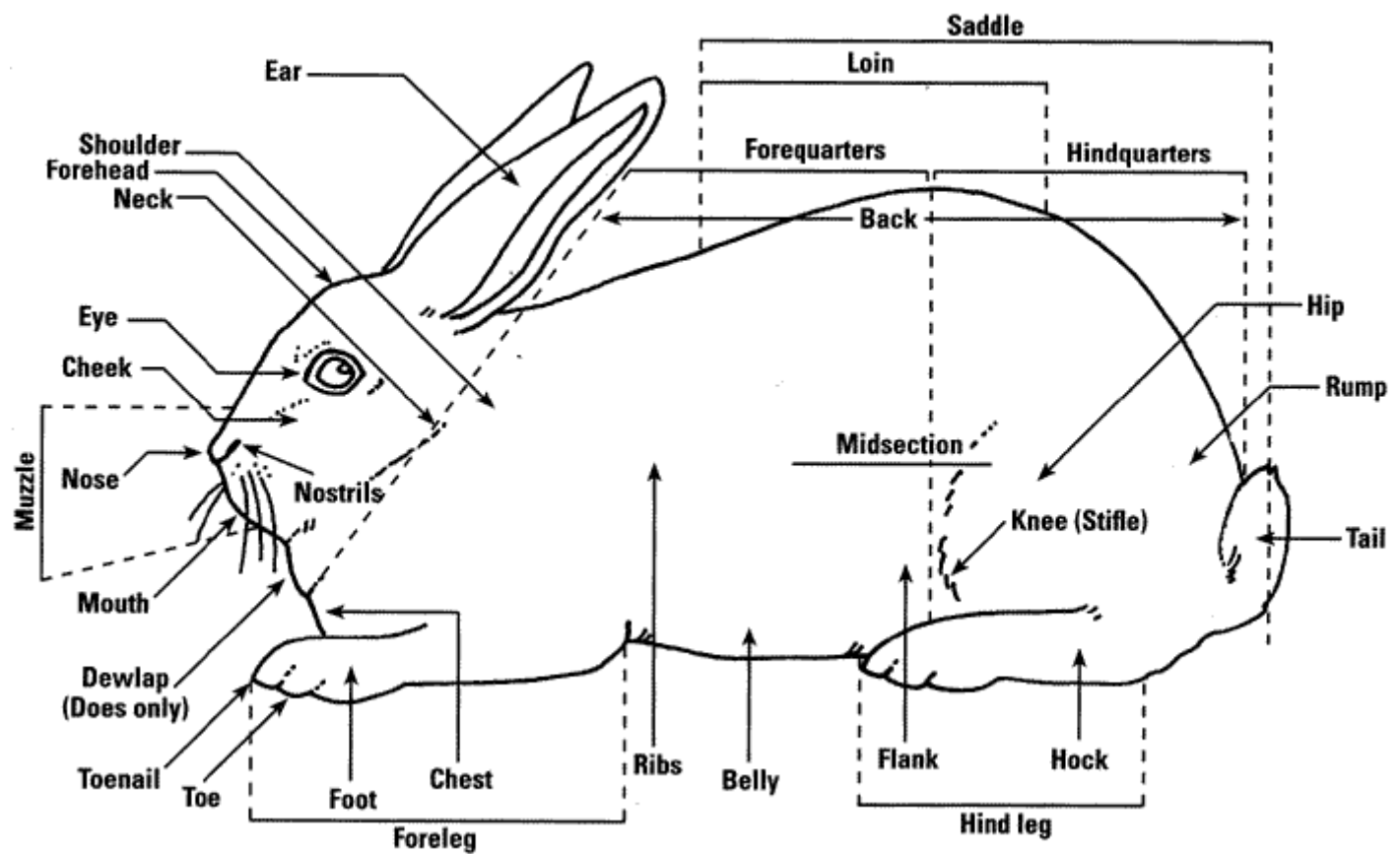
- Make a poster with the outline of a rabbit and rabbit body parts. Label all of the parts and discuss with the children
 - Two rabbit pictures with labeled body parts are attached. One is basic and one more advanced for older children
- Go over the poster with the students
- Let them ask questions
- Blank rabbit outline is attached. Give children writing utensil and have them label every part they can remember. Then get the poster back out and review how they labeled the rabbit

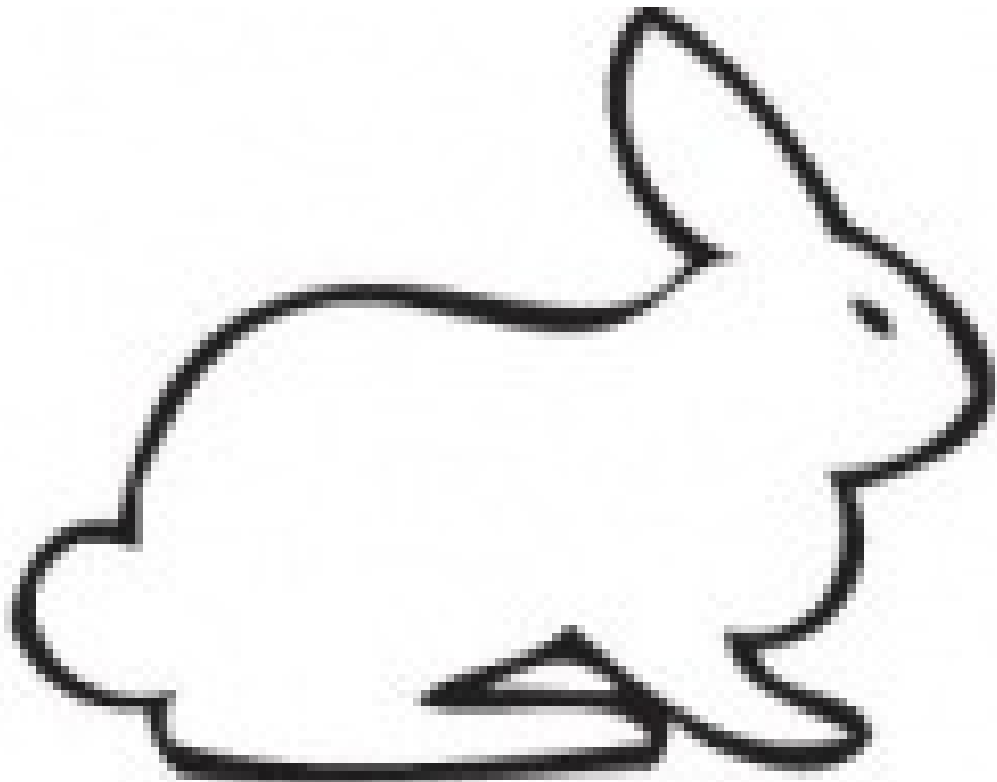
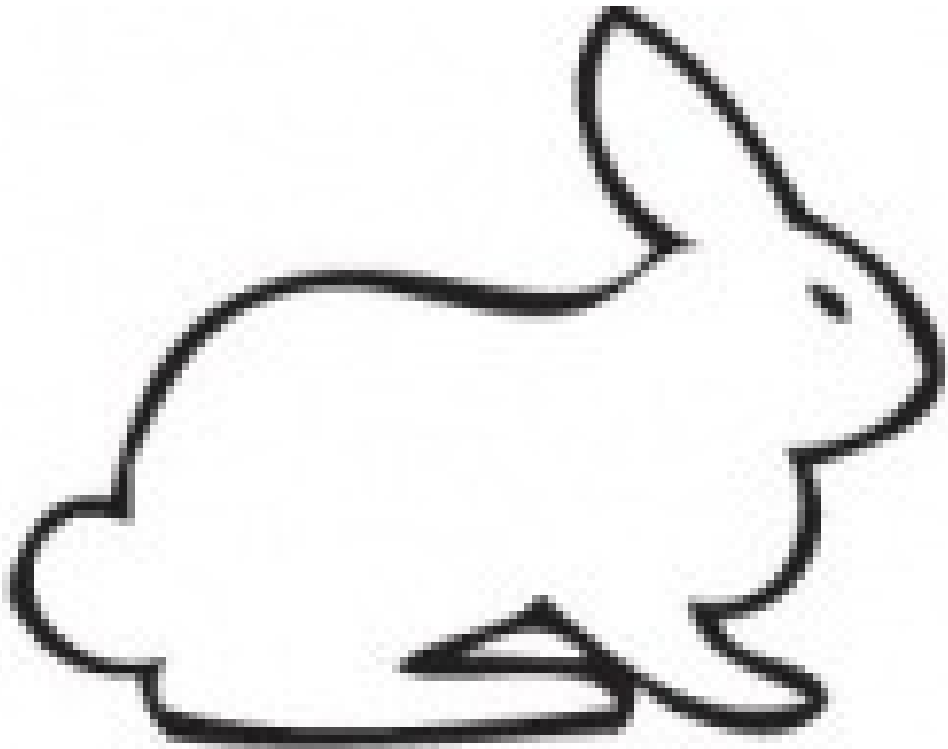
15 minutes: Coloring the Wood Cut out bunny

- Give them each a wood cut out of a bunny
- Let them paint or color the bunny anyway they would like
- Then give them a popsicle stick to attach to the bunny using glue once the paint is dry

25 minutes: Making an edible bunny

- Print outline of a rabbit on cardstock paper and cut out, making one for each student
- Give each student marshmallows, markers, and icing
- Let them stick the marshmallows on the cardstock using icing
- They can eat everything but the cardstock
