Objectives:

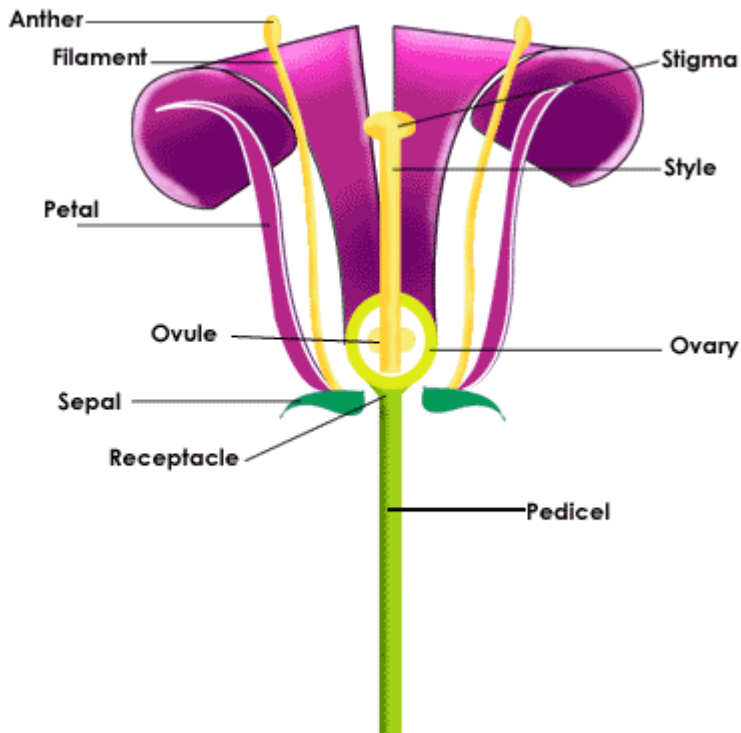
- Identify parts of a flower

Materials:

- Flower information/facts (instructor only)
- Parts of a flower (print out for each student)
- Paints
- Wooden figures (6 figures for each student)
- Magnets

Discuss the parts of a flower

Flower



Explain what a flower needs to survive, how flowers and plants help the environment, and a few more fun facts to remember about flowers.

- A flower needs sunlight and water to grow and be healthy
- Plants release chemicals into the environment that people and other living things need to live
- They take the carbon dioxide out of our air and give us oxygen to breathe
- Insects get proteins and carbohydrates from plants

Explain the project and why we will be doing it.

- Each student will receive 6 wooden figures that have something to do with flowers (These can be obtained from a local craft store). They will be painted and decorated individually. When completed we will attach magnets to the back.

The students will make/paint and decorate their flower magnets
