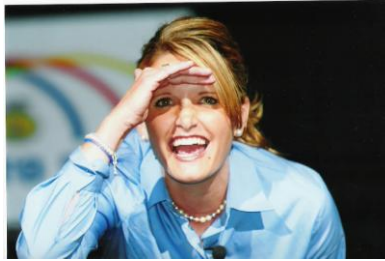


Andrea Lohr
