Follow Route 4 until you reach Route 72, also known as South Chapel Street/Library Avenue. Turn left on Route 72. Follow Route 72 North until you reach Wyoming Road. Turn left on Wyoming Road. Enter left into the UD driveway. You will then pass the Early Learning Center on your left, the Institute of Energy Conversion on your right, and the NCC Cooperative Extension Office will be in front of you.
