Science for Young Thinkers Cost: \$15
January 26, 2012 6:30-8:30 pm Level 2 (2 hours)
 You don't have to be a rocket scientist to help future scientists learn the basics. Find out how to make science activities really fun for children and adults.

Managing Money in a Child Care Setting Cost: Free

We will also discuss simple techniques to "find money" to save, where to put your savings, and identify motivators that will help you save.
