

Fees cover the cost of materials, evaluation compilation, certificate distribution and program supplies.

Debtor Education Course Fee: \$40/ Bankruptcy Case Number

Scholarships will be made available to those unable to pay this fee. If the student is receiving legal services pro-bono or if their sole source of income is disability, the fee may be waived by providing proof and contacting the instructor.
