



## Debtor Education Program Registration Form

University of Delaware Cooperative Extension Debtor Education program is provided to all individuals regardless of ability to pay. A course fee of \$40 will be assessed to offset expenses of the program. Scholarships will be made available to those unable to pay this fee. If the student is receiving legal services pro-bono, can show hardship or if their sole source of income is disability, the fee may be waived by providing proof and contacting the instructor. Method of payment will be a check made out to University of Delaware.

To apply for a scholarship, the student should contact the instructor. A letter of need from your lawyer or Bankruptcy trustee will be used to determine eligibility for scholarship.
