Introduction to Art History I (ARTH 153)—3 CREDITS

Painting, sculpture and architecture from Prehistoric times through ancient Egypt, Greece, Rome and the Middle Ages studied in historical and cultural context.

Appreciation of Music (MUSC 101) - 3 CREDITS

Introduction to Western music literature through a nontechnical presentation of various musical styles and forms.

Foreign Languages

Elementary Level - 4 Credits

105 = Less than 2 years of the same foreign language in high school, or 2 years only in 9th and 10th grades

Introduction to the language and development of speaking, listening, reading and writing skills through the use of basic texts.

Elementary/Intermediate Level —4 Credits

106 = 2-3 years of the same foreign language in high school

Completion of the basic language.

Review of grammar, continued practice in speaking and writing, and reading texts of average difficulty.
