<i>Helianthus</i> Sunshine Daybreak	ONLY 2 PLANTS TO START; 1 left 8/24; all gone 9/18
<i>Heliopsis</i> 'Tuscan Sun'	ONLY 3 PLANTS TO START; 2 plants left 8/24; can hardly see because of neighboring Ipomoea 9/18
<i>Ipomoea batatas</i> Chillin'® Blackberry Heart	something eating foliage 6/26; outgrown row 8/24; all Ipomoeas grown way outside space 9/4; would have been a 5 but something eating foliage, small holes not too noticeable 9/18
<i>Ipomoea batatas</i> Chillin'® Blackberry Star	something eating foliage 6/26; outgrown row 8/24; all Ipomoeas grown way outside space 9/4; would have been a 5 but something eating foliage, small holes not too noticeable 9/18

<i>Laurentia axillaris</i> Beth's Blue®	1 plant dead 7/24; 5 plants left 8/24
<i>Lobelia</i> Lavender Blush	all appear to be dying 9/4; all dying 9/18
<i>Lobelia erinus</i> Laguna™ Heavenly Lilac	4 plants dead 6/26; all appear to be dying 9/4; all dying 9/18
<i>Lobelia erinus</i> Laguna™ Sky blue	OUTSTANDING! 7/10; seedheads detracting 8/24
<i>Lobelia erinus</i> Lucia™ Dark Blue	5 plants left 8/24
<i>Lobularia maritima</i> Snow Princess™	OUTSTANDING! 7/10; seedheads detracting 8/24; so fragrant! 9/4
<i>Nicotiana alata</i> 'Perfume Deep Purple'	2 dead plants 7/10
<i>Nierembergia</i> Augusta™ Blue Skies	WOW, flowers varying shades of prple 9/4
<i>Ocimum basilicum</i> Queen of Sheba	very pretty dark purple bracts 7/10; Purple flower bracts spiky & ornamental 8/7; bracts are attraction-flowers tiny 8/24; bracts outstanding! 9/4
<i>Osteospermum</i> 'Asti White'	1 dead plant 7/10; 2 more dead 7/24; 1 more dead 8/7; only 1 still alive which is outstanding - overall group very poor 8/24
