

Archery Event Requirements/Rules:

1. Sign-up online prior to the event. Must be signed up to shoot. A sign-up deadline is established and no signups will occur at the event.
2. Shoot will occur at the REC, not at the Carvel Building.
3. A parent/guardian must attend with child(ren). No drop-offs. 5-7 adult volunteers will be needed for each shoot and the event will not be held without adequate adult helpers. The event may be cancelled at any time including after the start of the event for lack of an appropriate number of adult volunteers to supervise.
4. Due to safety instructions at the beginning of the shoot or session youth must be on time. Anyone arriving late will not be allowed to shoot.
5. Safety training will be conducted only at the first shoot for the season. All future shoots during the season will begin with shooting. Therefore only youth attending the first session with the safety training will be allowed to shoot at future shoots during the current season. Safety training will be repeated at the first shoot of the next season.
6. Only the first date will be publicized. Future dates will be announced at the event and only those attending the first shoot are invited to attend future shoots that season.
7. Youth with disciplinary or behavior problems are excused for the rest of the season. No exceptions. Safety and respect will come first. There are no warnings and a first offense is reason for being excused.
8. Youth may complete a shooting sports project and project book if they wish, but it is not required.
9. Youth will maintain a score sheet for all shoots. It is the youth's responsibility to bring the sheet to future shoots. Adult helpers will help with scoring and record keeping.
10. Parents may bring folding chairs. No seating will be provided.
11. There will need to be a minimum of 12 pre-registered youth to hold the event. If the event is cancelled an email will be sent out.
12. The event will be held outdoors and at the mercy of the weather. Rain or wind will cause the event to be cancelled and an email will be sent out. Notice may be short because weather changes with little notice. If the weather is bad assume it is cancelled.
13. Supplied bows are 15, 20, 30 lb recurves. Personal compound bows are allowed. Note that targets are light weight foam, not the heavy targets used at the state fair and may have problems with falling over due to the force exerted by compound bows. Shooting can not be repeatedly stopped to reset targets. Compound bow shooters must be familiar with their own bows including aiming, pins & matching distances, or use of sights. Instruction will be primarily for recurves.
14. All arrows must be target or field points, no hunting or broadheads.
15. Armguards are required unless the youth is wearing heavy long sleeves such as a coat or sweatshirt.
16. Finger tabs, gloves, or triggers are the shooter's choice. Bare fingers are allowed with lighter bows.
17. Minimum age for this event is 8 years old.
